## In brief

Belgium's tax dispute landscape has seen quite some developments both nationally and internationally over the past year. The Belgian tax authorities have gained more powers and access to data, while tax rules have become increasingly complex. This has led to a growing trend of more intricate, thorough, and cross-border tax audits. At the same time, the new Government has announced new tax rules that are relevant from a tax dispute perspective.

## Key takeaways

The 2025 global Baker McKenzie dispute report shows that many corporate groups remain concerned about the high dispute risk in the field of employee taxes.

During this session, we discussed the focus areas of the Belgian tax authorities that we are seeing, such as the wage tax incentives, cross-border remote/hybrid working schemes and the risk of triggering a PE, and gave practical tips and best practices on how to handle an audit in these fields. We also spoke on the plans of the new Government and other relevant developments (such as the 2025 Guidelines of Belspo) and considered how these may impact audit activity.
