



Please be aware of scam attempts and fraudulent communications

Many organizations have seen an increase in scam attempts and fraudulent communications. These often include the use of 'lookalike' domains impersonating our Firm and/or impersonation of staff members, as well as unauthorized use of our Firm's address, logo, photos, and profiles of our people. This can be, for example, in the form of emails, WhatsApp or text messages, social media pages and websites.

Genuine emails from Baker McKenzie Wong & Leow only use the domain "@bakermckenzie.com". Please be vigilant and exercise caution when it comes to any unusual or unexpected communications. Do not click on any links and attachments of suspicious or unusual emails and messages.

Be alert to any request over the phone about money transfers. We will never make such a request over the phone. Be also alert to fictitious job opportunity posts and offers of employment which claim to be in the name of Baker McKenzie Wong & Leow.

If you receive a communication purporting to be from or referring to Baker McKenzie Wong & Leow and are in any doubt about whether it is genuine, please call your usual Baker McKenzie Wong & Leow contact or our office on +65 6388 1888 to confirm before engaging with the sender.
