



## Representative Legal Matters

### William (Bill) D. McSpadden

William McSpadden has had a significant role in the litigation of many patent cases, including the following:

- Prosecuted a patent infringement case in the Eastern District of Texas related to welding technology. The case resulted in an agreed injunction and a financial settlement.
- Defended a consumer electronics company in a patent infringement lawsuit in the Northern District of Texas and before the Patent Trial and Appeal Board related to cordless telephone devices. The asserted patents were invalidated by the PTAB.
- Defended a financial software company in a patent infringement lawsuit in the Eastern District of Texas related to the processing of images of paper checks. The case was resolved when the asserted patents were invalidated by the PTAB.
- Prosecuted a patent infringement case in the Northern District of Texas related to orthopedic medical devices. The case was settled on favorable terms.
