

Representative Legal Matters Mikołaj Piaskowski

Antitrust

- Represented global industrial manufacturer in the dawn raid procedure carried out by the Polish competition authority and assisted in the risk assessment and leniency related analysis and succeeded in closing the case without bringing the charges against the client.
- Conducted an in-depth competition law audit of the Polish operations of an international retail company.

State aid
